

Certified Playground Safety Inspector Course and Exam

About the Course

Developed by the National Recreation and Park Association (NRPA), the Certified Playground Safety Inspector (CPSI) program is the most comprehensive training program on playground hazard identification and risk management methods offered.

CPSI is designed to educate and train individuals to identify and reduce risks. Advanced reading and fifteen hours of training from nationally known playground safety experts will prepare participants to sit for the Certified Playground Safety Inspector examination offered at the culmination of the certification course.

• **Course topics include**

- Identifying hazards on playgrounds
- Developing risk management tools
- Importance of comprehensive playground safety program from a legal perspective
- Test methods for entrapments, protrusions, and entanglement

Preparation

Advanced preparation and studying is essential to passing this course. A minimum of three weeks of study time is recommended; NRPA does not advise sitting for the exam if materials have not been read thoroughly.

Certification

Those taking the course are eligible to take the Playground Safety Inspectors Exam given immediately after the course. Upon successfully passing the exam, you will be certified through the National Recreation and Park Association as a Certified Playground Safety inspector (CPSI) for a three-year period. Certificates will be awarded and your name will be added to a national roster of CPSIs.
